



Hello! We are so excited that you'll be joining us for 2022 Summer Camps. We look forward to a safe and fun summer ahead as we've been planning all year for your child's arrival at our camp. Below, you will find our packing list. Please note that **Check-In is at 4:00pm** on the first day of your session. As we get closer to your session, we will send out more information on Check-In guidelines. On the last day of the session, you can expect a **Closing Service at 11:00am**.

Packing List

1. **Summer clothes; light pants or jeans for the ropes course.** This includes clothes that are able to get messy. Remember, running around in the hot Florida weather will require clothes that are comfortable. May also want to bring a light jacket or hoodie due to temperature change from outside to inside.
2. **Bathing suit(s).** Campers will have the opportunity to be in the water every day. While there are places to hang bathing suits to dry, we advise bringing multiple. Please bring appropriate fitting suits.
3. **Tennis shoes and flipflops.** Because of the many bugs that can be found outside, it is recommended that you bring two pairs of Tennis Shoes. We allow campers to wear flipflops when they are going to the pool. We also suggest a 2nd pair of closed-toed shoes for waterfront activities such as canoeing.
4. **Sunscreen and insect repellent.** While we will have these on hand, please bring a sunscreen and insect repellent that you know works with your skin.
5. **Rain jacket.** In Florida, rain is to be expected.
6. **One towel for showers, 2nd towel for pool/waterfront.**
7. **Twin fitted sheet, blanket or sleeping bag (small pillow and blanket are provided but camper may prefer their own).**
8. **Toiletries and a carrying case for them.** Part of our Covid protocols involves making sure 'stuff' isn't left in spaces where multiple people are abiding. Because of this, please bring something like a 'shower caddy' that can hold your toiletries. Don't forget deodorant!!!
9. **Flashlight.** It gets dark at camp, have a small flashlight isn't required but certainly helpful.
10. **White, 100% cotton clothing to be tie-dyed (if camper desires).** There will be plenty of chances for tie-dying at camp, we will provide the materials and bags for carrying.
11. **Medicines in their original containers.** Along with this, please attach a note that explains what times the medicine should be administered.
12. **Multiple masks.** There will be times this summer where we must wear masks in large and small group setting in adherence with our Covid prevention guidelines. Please consider bringing multiple, comfortable, appropriate fitting masks. Things such as hand sanitizer and wipes will be provided.
13. **Optional.** While at Camp, each session will have special activities that you can bring special outfits for. If there are any themed days, we will announce those prior to the session and let you know in your Check-In Information email.
